



## OOL PDF Terms of Supply to Schools or Colleges

1. Oxford Open Learning (OOL) supplies PDFs on the basis of an annual licence (renewable) which runs for 12 months from the date of access being granted to the "unlocked" PDF.
2. Each PDF (or a group of PDFs) may be purchased by a school or college ("the purchaser") for use within the school environment only.
3. Such usage may include copying of the PDF onto an internal network as long as that network is not accessible to users from outside the environment of that particular school or college.
4. PDFs may also be copied to individual PCs within the school environment.
5. PDFs (or any part thereof) may be printed (in A4 format) on any printer on school premises for the duration of the licence.
6. PDFs may be viewed or printed (by teachers or students of the school or college) an unlimited number of times during the period of the licence.
7. Teachers may extract sections of a PDF (in printed form) for use within teaching programmes of any kind on the premises.
8. PDFs (or printed copies taken from PDFs) may not be sold to any third party and should not be subject to any internal financial transaction for their usage.
9. Although every care has been taken that each PDF matches a named specification (normally AQA), OOL does not guarantee that every topic is covered to an equal depth or that the PDF represents a complete and self-sufficient "course". The school or college remains responsible for the delivery of a rounded educational programme based on these resources. Similarly, there is no undertaking that the materials are suitable for students of every ability-level or that specific grades may be achieved.
10. Where specified, some PDFs require that the student should have access to a named supporting textbook (or books) for full functionality. GCSE PDFs which do not require a supporting textbook for effective usage are: Business Studies, Business & Communication Systems, Economics, English, English Literature, French, Geography, ICT, Law, Mathematics, Psychology, Sociology and Spanish. Nevertheless, within these titles, advice is given on other supporting resources.
11. Additional non-digital resources are required for the full functionality of the following PDFs: French GCSE (tape), Geography GCSE (map), French 'A' level (tape). 10 free copies of these items may be claimed by the purchaser. Further copies may be purchased at £3 per item (plus p + p).
12. Printed copies of these resources may be ordered from OOL (01865-794357) only when the licence for electronic access has already been purchased. Printed copies are issued in the standard OOL 4-ring binder. They cost £25 per copy per title (GCSE or AS) or £35 for a complete A-level (zero-rated for VAT purposes).
13. As part of the licence fee, OOL also supplies (as a separate PDF) a set of suggested answers to each of the assignments contained within the main PDF. Schools may wish to restrict student access to this subsidiary PDF.
14. OOL undertakes that all parts of each PDF may be viewed (and printed) via a current version of Acrobat Reader.
15. Although OOL reserves the right to modify PDFs as time goes by (e.g. in response to specification change), the purchaser is not entitled to updates within the 12 month period of the licence, unless there are exceptional circumstances.
16. The purchaser will be offered the chance to renew the licence (for any purchased title) for a reduced fee after 12 months (and receive a revised PDF).
17. If the licence is not renewed, the school or college undertakes to take all feasible steps as soon as the licence period is over to delete all copies of the PDF from all networks and PCs on which it is stored and to prevent any further printed copies being made of any part of the PDF.
18. A named representative of the school or college, e.g. the ICT Coordinator, should indicate assent to these terms and conditions and take responsibility for enforcing them.
19. OOL reserves the right to take legal action against any school or college which deliberately breaks the terms of this agreement or through demonstrable negligence allows these terms to be abused.
20. This agreement is covered by English law.
